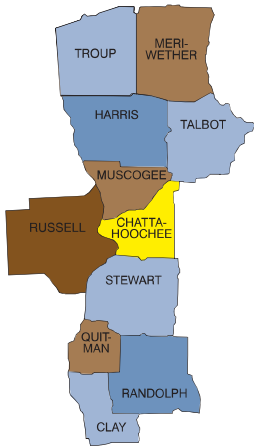

STABILIZING

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program helps households with low-incomes pay their home heating and cooling bills.

Assessments, Goal Setting and Case Management services are provided to families to help them become self sufficient/economically stable.

SERVICES PROVIDED



EMPLOYMENT TRAINING

A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and clinical activities which prepare an individual to become a CNA (Certified Nurse Aide) in a short period of time.



A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and hands-on driving activities which prepare an individual to obtain either a Class A or Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) in less than 8 weeks.



A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and on the job training which prepares an individual to receive a certification in Facilities Maintenance in as little as 6 to 8 weeks.

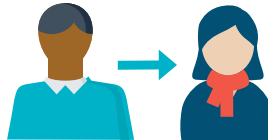

Early Head Start

Early Head Start is a national program that promotes healthy prenatal outcomes for pregnant women and early child development for children 6 weeks to 3 years old. ESP served 10 children and their families. The cost per child is \$14,661.



Employment Training

The Employment Training Service provides instructional courses and hands-on experience in the nursing assistant, commercial driving and facility maintenance fields. To date, there have been no students that participated from Chattahoochee County.



Head Start

Head Start is a national school readiness program that provides comprehensive services to children, between the ages of 3 to 5 and their families. ESP served 19 children and their families. The cost per child is \$12,120.

Energy Assistance/ LIHEAP

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps families pay their home heating and cooling bills to prevent service disconnection. ESP assisted 177 households. \$79,430 was expended for services.
