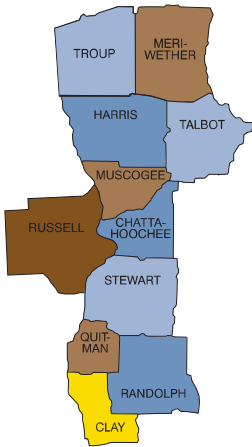

SERVICES PROVIDED



EDUCATION

Early Head Start promotes healthy prenatal outcomes, enhances the development of infants and toddlers, and promotes healthy family functioning.

Head Start is a national school readiness program. It provides comprehensive education, health, nutrition and parent involvement services to children, ages 3 to 5 and their families.



STABILIZING

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program helps households with low-incomes pay their home heating and cooling bills.



Enrichment Services Program, Inc. partners with Feeding the Valley to implement this food distribution program that provides a food package to participants once a month. The food package is designed to improve the health of recipients by supplementing their diets with nutritious USDA commodity foods that are designed to provide protein, calcium, iron and vitamins A and C.



FAMILY STRENGTHENING

Assessments, Goal Setting and Case Management services are provided to families to help them become self sufficient/economically stable.

SERVICES PROVIDED



EMPLOYMENT TRAINING

A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and clinical activities which prepare an individual to become a CNA (Certified Nurse Aide) in a short period of time.



A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and hands-on driving activities which prepares an individual to obtain either a Class A or Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) in less than 8 weeks.



A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and on the job training which prepares an individual to receive a certification in Facilities Maintenance in as little as 6 to 8 weeks.

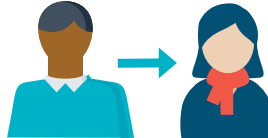

Employment Training

The Employment Training Service provides instructional courses and hands-on experience in the nursing assistant, commercial driving and facility maintenance fields. To date, there have been no students that have participated from Clay County.



Early Head Start

Early Head Start is a national program that promotes healthy prenatal outcomes for pregnant women and early child development for children 6 weeks to 3 years old. ESP served 9 children and their families for EHS-CCP (Childcare Partnership). The cost per child is \$16,290.



Head Start

Head Start is a national school readiness program that provides comprehensive services to children, between the ages of 3 to 5 and their families. ESP served 19 children and their families. The cost per child is \$12,120.

Food Commodities Distribution

Food goods are distributed through a partnership with Feeding the Valley Food Bank. Commodities are provided monthly to approximately 140 households in Clay County.



Utility Assistance LIHEAP/LIHWAP Program

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps families pay their home heating bills to prevent service disconnection. ESP assisted 275 households; \$92,865 was expended for services.
