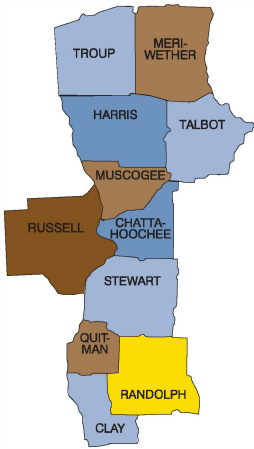

STABILIZING

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program helps households with low-incomes pay their home heating and cooling bills.



Enrichment Services Program, Inc. partners with Feeding the Valley to implement a food distribution program that provides a food package to participants once a month. The food package is designed to improve the health of recipients by supplementing their diets with nutritious USDA commodity foods that are designed to provide protein, calcium, iron and vitamins A and C.



EMPLOYMENT TRAINING

A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and clinical activities which prepare an individual to become a CNA (Certified Nurse Aide) in a short period of time.

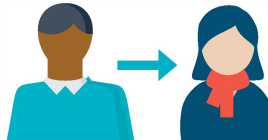

Food Commodities Distribution

Food goods are distributed through a partnership with Feeding the Valley Food Bank. Commodities are provided monthly to approximately 595 households in Randolph County.



Employment Training

The Employment Training Service provides scholarships for instructional courses and hands-on experience in the nursing assistant, commercial driving and facility maintenance fields. To date, there were no students who participated from Randolph County.



Utility Assistance LIHEAP

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps families pay their home heating and cooling bills to prevent service disconnection. ESP assisted 400 households. \$174,042 was expended for services.
