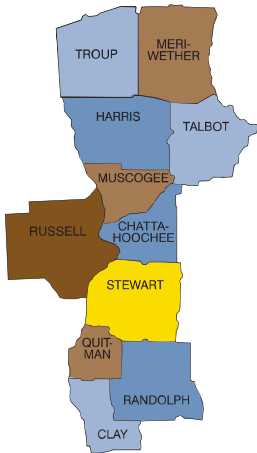

## SERVICES PROVIDED



### EDUCATION

Early Head Start promotes healthy prenatal outcomes, enhances the development of infants and toddlers, and promotes healthy family functioning.

Head Start is a national school readiness program. It provides comprehensive education, health, nutrition and parent involvement services to children, ages 3 to 5 and their families.



### STABILIZING

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program helps households with low-incomes pay their home heating and cooling bills.



Enrichment Services Program, Inc. partners with Feeding the Valley to implement a food distribution program that provides a food package to participants once a month. The food package is designed to improve the health of recipients by supplementing their diets with nutritious USDA commodity foods that are designed to provide protein, calcium, iron and vitamin A and C.



### FAMILY STRENGTHENING

Assessments, Goal Setting and Case Management services are provided to families to help them become self sufficient/economically stable.

## SERVICES PROVIDED



### EMPLOYMENT TRAINING

A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and clinical activities which prepare an individual to become a CNA (Certified Nurse Aide) in a short period of time.



A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and hands-on driving activities which prepare an individual to obtain either a Class A or Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) in less than 8 weeks.



A scholarship is provided for classroom instruction and on the job training which prepares an individual to receive a certification in Facilities Maintenance in as little as 6 to 8 weeks.

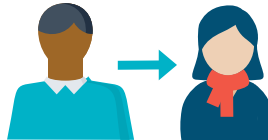

## DEPARTMENT OF EARLY CHILDHOOD AND FAMILY SERVICES

\$114,714 was expended for services



## Early Head Start

Early Head Start is a national program that promotes healthy prenatal outcomes for pregnant women and early child development for children 6 weeks to 3 years old. ESP served 12 children and their families for EHS Expansion. The cost per child is \$12,218.



## Head Start

Head Start is a national school readiness program that provides comprehensive services to children, between the ages of 3 to 5 and their families. ESP served 19 children and their families. The cost per child is \$12,120.

## Employment Training

The Employment Training Service provides instructional courses and hands-on experience in the nursing assistant, commercial driving and facility maintenance fields. To date, there have been no students that participated from Stewart County.



## Food Commodities Distribution

Food goods are distributed through a partnership with Feeding the Valley Food Bank. Commodities are provided monthly to approximately 175 households in Stewart County.



## Energy Assistance/ LIHEAP Program

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps families pay their home heating and cooling bills to prevent service disconnection. ESP assisted with 253 payments. \$114,714 was expended for services.
